


Campus S – Key Facts

Complementary training

General

 Campus S is a user training to optimize the profitability of your **kolb** cleaning system – ideal if you want to make yourself and your team fit for a more efficient and sustainable operation in addition to the practical installation training or retraining.



Theory



The theory parts of the Campus S training program are completed online via an e-learning portal. You decide how long and how quickly you complete them. We recommend completing them before the practical part with a minimum target achievement of 65 %. As soon as you have successfully completed the theory parts, you will receive an official confirmation of your learning success.

Practice



The practical part of the Campus S training program takes place as part of a practical installation training or retraining directly on your **kolb** cleaning system in your company – carried out by a certified **kolb** service trainer. You will receive a detailed, system-related process description after commissioning.



Certificate & handout

A digital handout and a certificate of attendance will be provided to you at the end.

Participation fee
